#### **Course content:**


The course aims to provide a general overview of the principles and main provisions of the Act.

- Go to the **Learner Homepage** either from the side menu bar or via the Portlet










Click on the magnifying glass next to the **Mental Health Act** competency.

This will ensure you complete the correct course and your record will update correctly.










Now ensure you click on the 'Choose or Enrol in Class' button next to the course.





On the next page click Apply.

Click the Play button next to the course to launch the e-Learning.








#### Important points!
